Spokane Valley offers 343 acres of unique parks, trails and open spaces from small neighborhood playgrounds to larger multi-use parks.



## Reserve a Park Shelter or Ball Field

Reservations are available from **April 15 through October 15**. To reserve a facility, complete a Facility Use Application and payment at [SpokaneValleyWA.gov/Parks](https://spokanevalleywa.gov/Parks) or visit the Parks and Recreation Office at CenterPlace Regional Event Center.

## Appleway Trail [SpokaneValleyWA.gov/ApplewayTrail](https://spokanevalleywa.gov/ApplewayTrail)

5.1 miles of paved trail from University Road to Liberty Lake. Constructed on the old Milwaukee Railroad right-of-way that parallels the Sprague Avenue corridor. Trailheads are located at University, Pines, Best and Tschirley Roads.

40 miles of paved trail from Nine Mile Falls to Idaho State Line and generally follows the Spokane River.
